### **INFORMATION ABOUT NF's RANKING AND WORLD CUP QUOTAS ATTRIBUTION FROM ICF RANKING**

**1° All National Federations affiliated to the ICF and with their membership fee paid, could enter, at least, one boat per event at the CSL World cup.**

**2° To fulfill the Article 44.3.1 of the Canoe Slalom Rules, the Technical Committee has established a Ranking of the federations for each event from the 2009 CSL ICF Ranking.**

**3° For 2010, an Official C1W World cup series will be held and, as a developing class, will be limited to 3 boats per federation for the 2010 World Cup season.**

**The ranking for the federations in all other events (K1M, K1W, C1M and C2M) is established as follows:**

#### **Example for K1 MEN**

**From the ICF ranking, as per 1st of November 2009, we calculate the first federation who has 4 boats ranked in the highest position, it receive the rank position N°1, the second who has 4 boats ranked is second and following we establish the ranking of the 25<sup>th</sup> first federations.**

**We ranked firstly the federations who have 4 boats ranked within the 200 first K1M ranked, and then the federations with only 3 boats.**
