Details:

You must use the 'Peak UK' Logo or Icon (as created above) but it must cover a minimum size of 40mm by 20 mm, on an a4 size poster (Scale as required – See below for actual size on A4).

You must include the 'BCU Slalom Committee' Logo (or Icon as created above), it must be a minimum of 20mm tall. Entrants are asked to enter into the spirit of this competition which is to make the best poster possible, and as such you may manipulate the logo's however you like but not obscure them, you can change background colours, provided logo's can still be clearly seen.

There are NO restrictions on further advertising and logos that you would already or may in future get, to put on your posters.

The poster must be posted on CanoeSlalomUK in the run up to your event during the 2012 season (Closing Date 4th Nov 2012). Nick Penfold, has kindly agreed to collate them again, as this year, nick.penfold@canoeslalom.co.uk All BCU Ranking Slalom Events between 1st March – 4th Nov 2012, are eligible.
