

## Lee Valley Olympic Course –Competency Criteria for Public Slalom Access

The Lee Valley Whitewater Course remains open to the public for canoeists and if you have not already completed the induction process, this paper aims to assist in the assessment of competence before being allowed to paddle in public sessions.

There will be winter canoeing only sessions available on the Olympic course and the legacy loop as well as access to rafting slots (subject to number limits). The gates policy will vary from session to session so please check with the centre. Details of winter opening and additional sessions can be found on their website [www.gowhitewater.co.uk](http://www.gowhitewater.co.uk).

In principle the following competency criteria based upon Canoe Slalom rankings in Premier have been agreed between the BCU slalom Committee and Simon Ricketts (LVWWC centre Manager) for access to public sessions.

This does not infer any right to access the public sessions or exclusive sessions. This merely provides a level of competency inferred through ranking. Then it is up to an individual to sign any necessary induction forms, make bookings and pay the necessary admin and course fees.

Paddlers achieving the following points in Premier are listed to be deemed to be confident to paddle on Lee Valley Olympic and Legacy courses. If an individual does not feel competent to do this then they should not participate.

Taken from the 2010 premier ranking:

K1W over 50 points  
K1M over 500 points  
C1W over 500 points  
C1M over 50 points  
C2 over 500 points

Based upon 2011 premier ranking so far:

K1W average of 300 points  
K1M average 300 points  
C1W average – 300 points  
C1M average 300 points  
C2 average – 300 points

The athletes named below would all be accepted for competency on the Lee Valley Whitewater Centre Olympic and Legacy courses subject to them agreeing to an induction and the terms and conditions outlined in them.
