### **2026 Selection process**

For the purposes of 2026 calendar planning, the International Panel wish to announce an intention to hold selection in a similar format across up to 2 venues on the following dates in 2026:

# 28/29 March 2026 11/12 April 2026

The venues will be announced by the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025 to enable further discussions with the Slalom Committee, National Associations and managed calendar process.

The International Panel will seek feedback on the 2025 selection process to help inform the proposals for the 2026 policy which will be consulted upon in the autumn.
