Updates Following the first weekend of the 2026 selection series

Firstly the International Panel would like to thank everyone involved in delivering the first weekend of the 2026 selection series, in particular our thanks to the Lee Valley Paddlesports Club who took on the race organisation. The weather conditions at times were challenging, particularly on Sunday so thanks to everyone for your commitment.

Information & Updates:

We look forward to the second weekend at Holme Pierrepont organised by Holme Pierrepont Canoe Club on 11th/12th April and ahead of this the International Panel wishes to share some important information and updates:

Kayak Cross Results - Important Information

- Following initial verification of the results data from the Lee Valley selection weekend, the International Panel and the PUK Slalom Timing Team have identified a potential technical error that relates to the Kayak Cross timing data with the issue pin-pointed to the automated start system built into the Kayak Cross ramp.

It is important to stress that the issue relates to the automatic starting system built into the Kayak Cross ramp, so there is no concern over the integrity of the canoe slalom results which have been checked against back ups to verify that the issue only relates to Kayak Cross.

The IP and timing team will continue to investigate further and the IP will meet next week to review the findings and consider the implications once the extent of the issue is known and understood. In the meantime, we would like to take the opportunity to thank our volunteer timing team for their support in working through the analysis. For this reason, the Kayak Cross results remain provisional. The International panel will not comment further until it has isolated, understood the issue and had a chance to discuss. This is being managed by the International panel, **PLEASE DO NOT CONTACT THE TIMING TEAM OR SLALOM COMMITTEE**.

Exceptional Circumstances:

- The International Panel wishes to share that a request for exceptional circumstances has been received from Nikita Setchell relating to Kayak Cross selection following an incident during the kayak cross competition and subsequent withdrawal on medical advice on Sunday 29th March. The IP will consider the details in conjunction with the wording in section 21 of the published selection policy and provide an update as part of the scheduled team announcement on Tuesday 14th April.
